## FRESH Rules

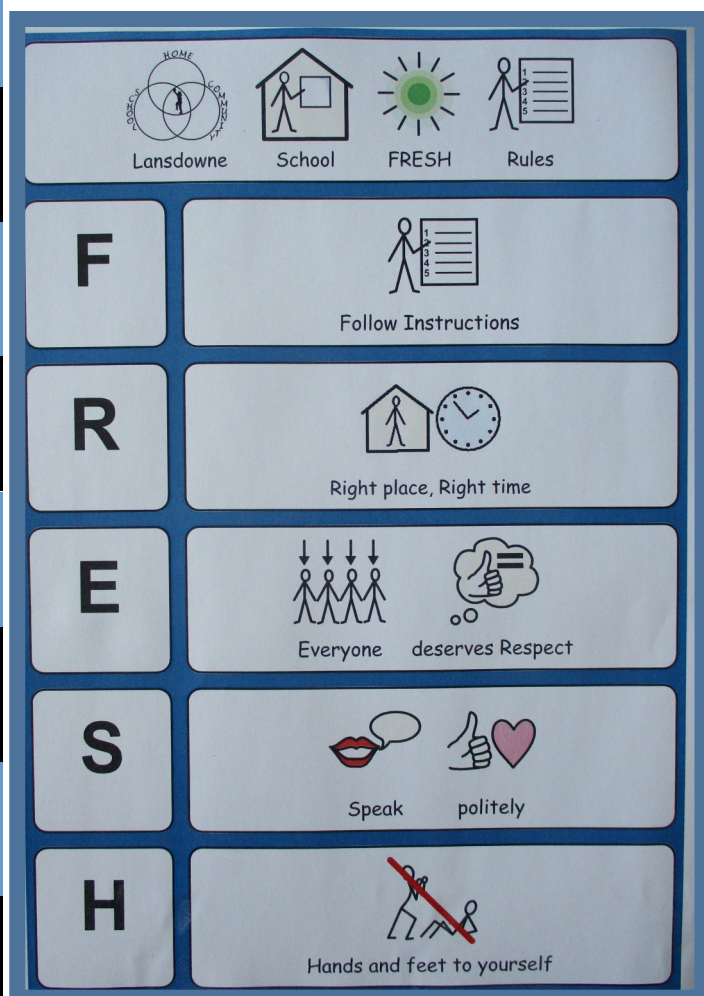
At Lansdowne we work using the FRESH rules to encourage students to behave appropriately.

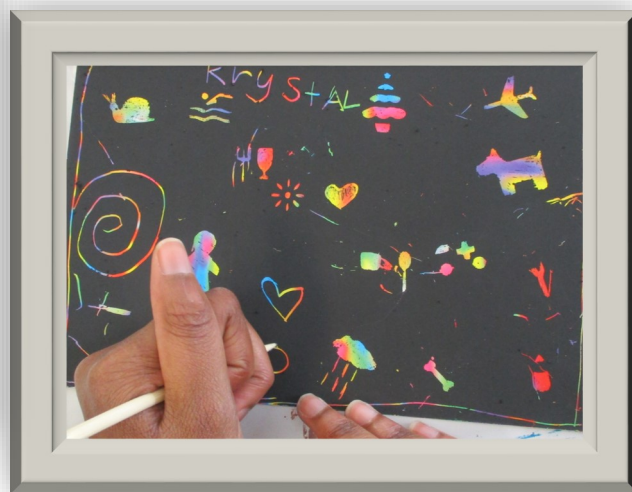
Pupils can use their praise post cards once a week in tuckshop during break time at school.
