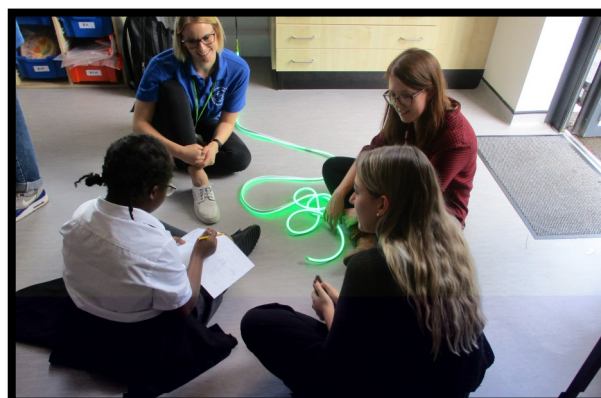
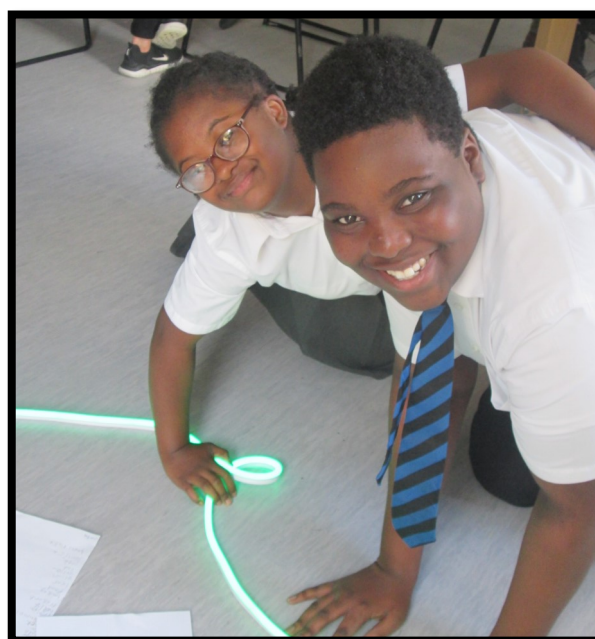

what we learned this week

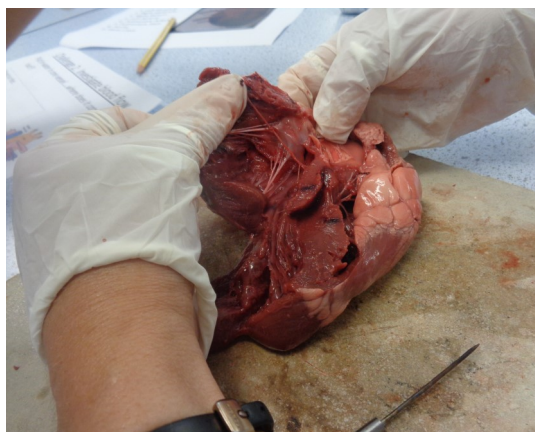
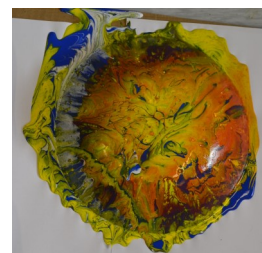
Art

Students poured paint onto a plastic lid previously used for food items and

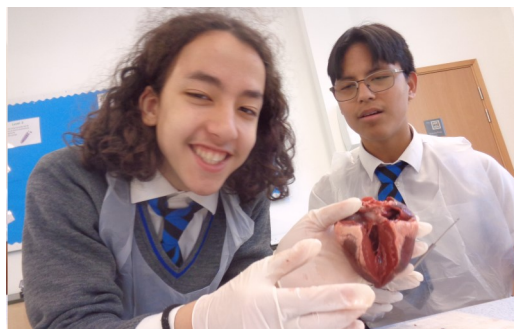
