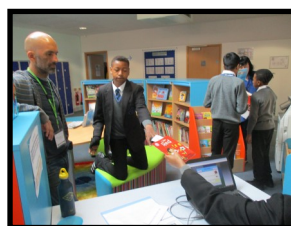

We are delighted that we now have student library monitors and gardeners in place.

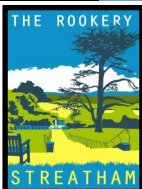
They carry out their duties every morning. Each student who applied for these positions had to respond to an advert about the job and then engaged in an interview process.

They were interviewed by our new assistant head teacher, Mr Downing and Mr Jukes. For the library positions, our librarian, Haven, also joined the interview panel.

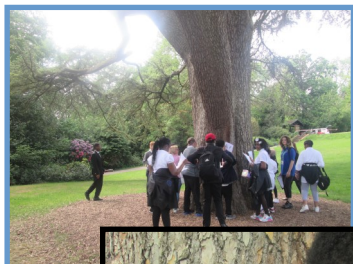
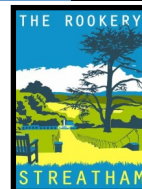
All the students are working well and we intend to give other students the opportunity to access these roles in the future.

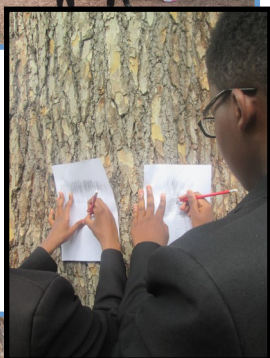
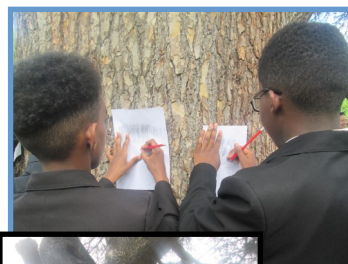




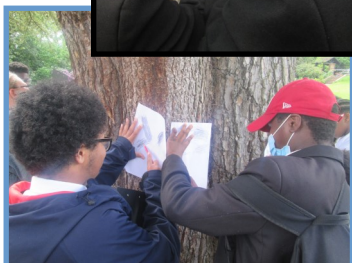
streatham Rookery

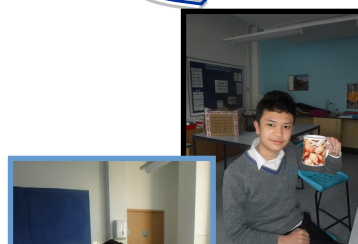
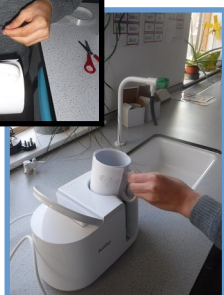
