9VG and 10EM's mural

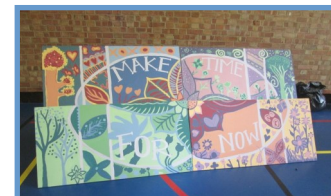


This week 9VG and 10EM finished making their mural!
