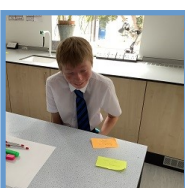
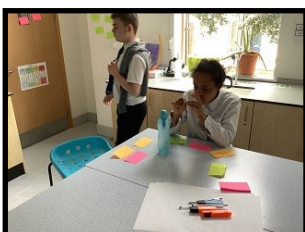
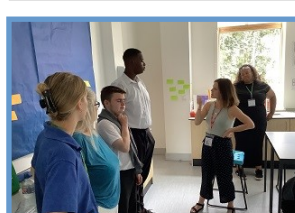
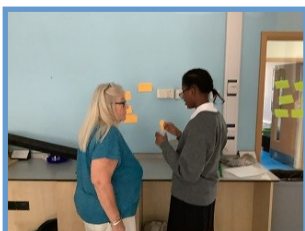
Their next activity involved searching the room for sticky notes labelled with the skills that they possess.
