All of the students had fun & enjoyed seeing what they had constructed.

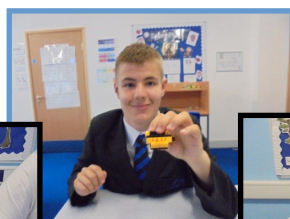
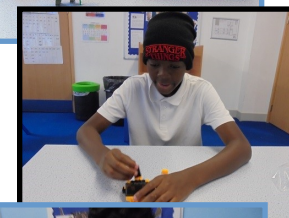
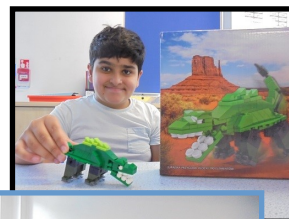
