Forest School



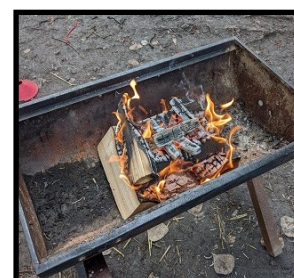
This week saw the start of a new term at Lansdowne's Forest School!

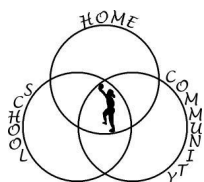

This week we have been learning some core skills including knot tying, shelter building and fire making - as well as team work of course!

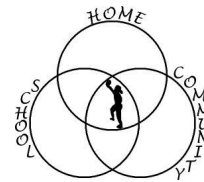
