Roots & Shoots

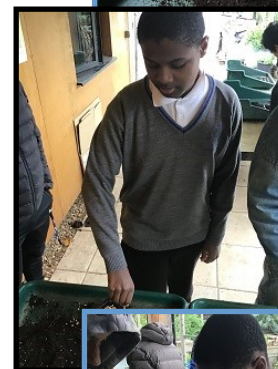


Every Tuesday and Thursday we send groups to Roots and Shoots.

Kew Gardens

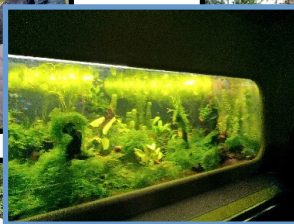
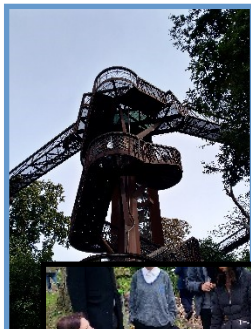


On Friday on the 30th of September, 11LC took a trip to Kew Gardens.
