We hope you all enjoy getting to know the program over the coming weeks!

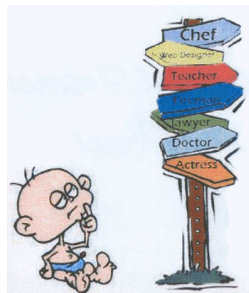


what we learned this week
