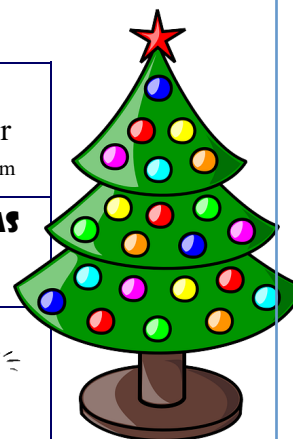

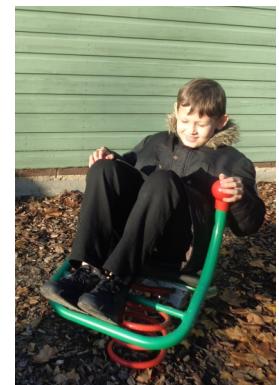
where we were this week

what we learned this week

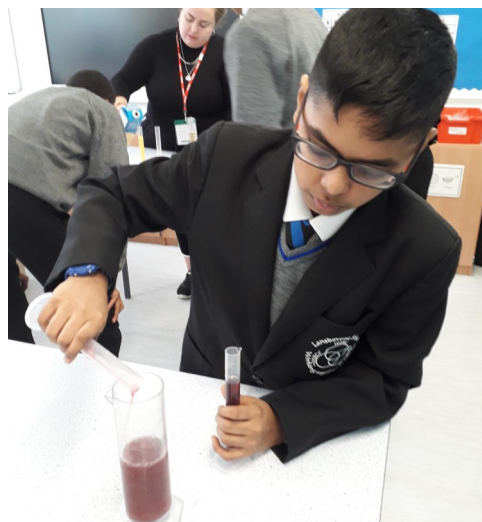
Last week we held the final Dramatic Maths session for our M2 and M3 students, on the topic of capacity.
