



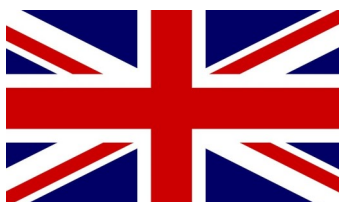
LANSDOWNE SCHOOL NEWSLETTER

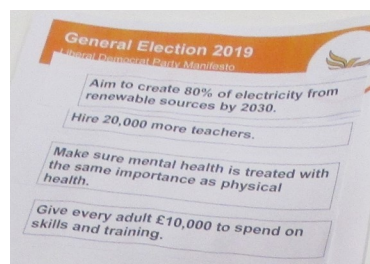

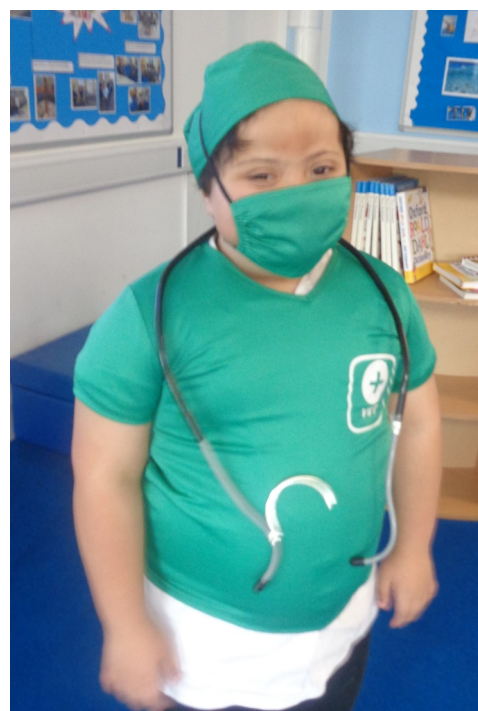
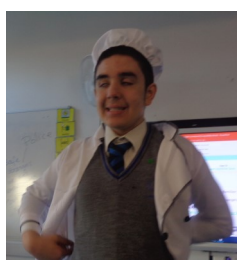


what we learned this week
