We realise that many families will be affected by the second Lockdown and the restrictions inherent in that, but it should be a comfort that schools remain open so that the education of young people can


continue. Thank you to all the parents who have supported our older children this week with their online learning through the google platform. The partnership between schools and parents and carers is more important than ever in the current situation.
