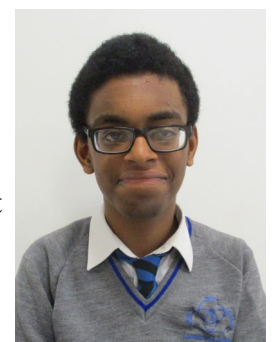
Yoel Year 11:
