I like food tech and I will miss all the cooking. I will miss my friends and the teachers and TAs.

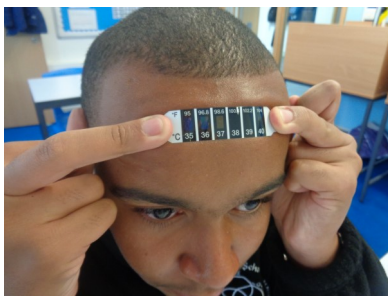
