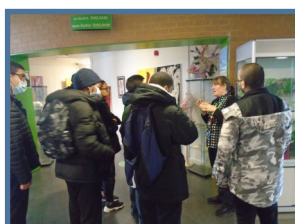

First, we made a chocolate brownie mix.

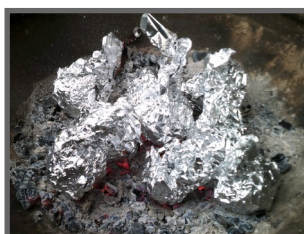
Next, we hollowed out some oranges, and spooned a small amount of our brownie mix into each one.
