Student Council Meeting Minutes
2nd December 2021 at 9:30am

Welcome

Mr Jukes welcomed the Student Council Members to the meeting today which was held virtually using Google Classroom in light of current COVID restrictions.

Discussion

Mr. Jukes asked for Student Council Members to share any points they want to raise:
