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Phonics Lessons

This week, in a Phonic Phase 5 group, we have been learning the 'or' sound and its alternative spellings. We have noticed that 'or' can often be found in the middle of a word as in 'sport and born' whilst 'aw' can often be found at the end of a word as in 'saw and straw'. The students seem mostly confident when reading and writing words with those spellings. Well done all!
