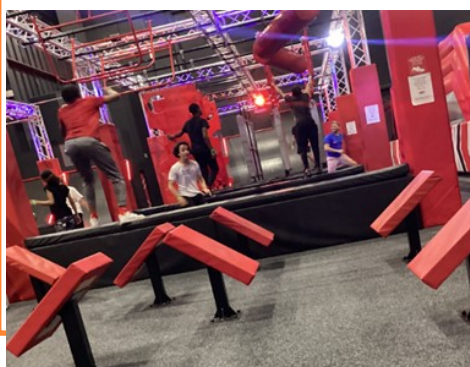
Post 19 Transition Fair

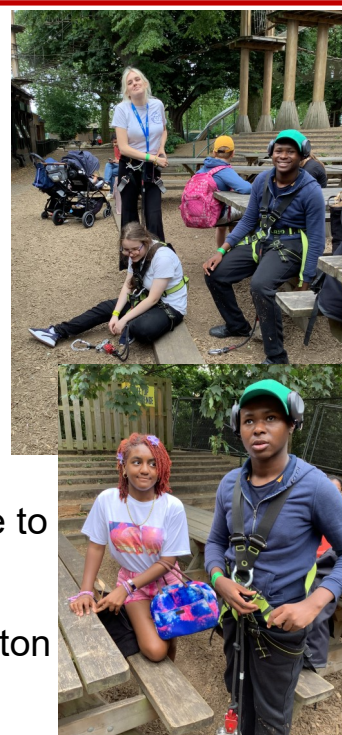
Forest School trip to Go Ape!
