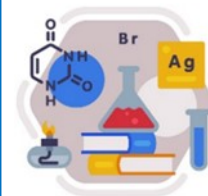


Maths

Exams – Students have been developing their knowledge on exam style questions and working through practice exams over the past terms. Students will now be taking part in their entry level exams.



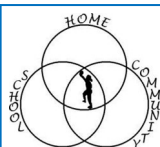
Environmental Management
